

Criteria for Change to Major Status in Aerospace Engineering from another Major, Pre-Major or Undeclared Status

If you wish to change to the **major** status in **AE** from another major, pre-major, or undeclared status, you will need to satisfy the following requirements:

1. You must have **completed MATH 150, MATH 151, CHEM 202 or 200, PHYS 195 and PHYS 196, and AE 200 or ME 200; and received a grade of C or better in each course.**
